## As 2018 comes to a close....

Sorry for the delays in the Newsletters coming to our membership but I am sure our members have seen all the wonderful projects we have been up to.

### HIGHLIGHTS

We have had a very busy fall including a remarkable concert with the True North Band on October 5th. Thank you to Carol Harley with the support of St. Stephen’s Episcopal Church and the True North Band and we raised over \$1000 for Missoula Children’s Theatre.

We then followed up with Repertory Dance Theatre from Salt Lake City did a remarkable performance at Baker High School and the next day did wonderful community outreach at Meadowbrook and at Crossroads. This performance was funded by Westaf (Western States Art Federation) with a grant from the National Endowment for the Arts, St. Luke’s/Eastern Oregon Medical Associates, Oster/Cook Family, Della Steele and Good Bear Ranch.

We then moved right into our “On Broadway” Crossroads Gala Fundraiser Dinner and Auction on October 20, 2018.

Thank you to those who came for a wonderful evening of good food, music and friendship. It was a wonderful evening celebrating Broadway! We thank all of you for attending, donating, dressing up, making centerpieces and making it a night to remember!

We are busy raising the additional funds we did not raise at Gala and if you can help please drop off at donation at Crossroads.

Thank you Andrea Stone and some wonderful volunteers who had a free MAKE it and take it Christmas ornament event at the US Capital Christmas Tree visit to Baker city. We thank HATCH for giving our volunteers a Warm spot!

We moved directly into the production of our first city wide circulation of a new quarterly class schedule. It came out in the Baker City Herald on November 28th and went out in every mailbox in the Baker City Herald Circular on December 6th. We hope you like the new layout and share it with friends and neighbors. We need to get more people taking classes across our community! This was a huge project and we are very proud of it!

We then moved into #givingtuesday, the efforts around the globe, to have a day after all the busy Christmas Shopping to focus on giving to our favorite charitable endeavors. Crossroads staff and Board of Directors worked together to raise awareness of ArtSpeak. With all our efforts online and with people dropping off checks we brought in over \$2500.00 and we still need more! Remember we need to raise \$10,000 to match the National Endowment for the Arts Challenge America Grant. We are still waiting to hear from Benevity and their Twitter #givingtuesday campaign in which staff battled out sharing the Benevity Giving Tuesday video and for every tweet made \$10 for Crossroads.

We have been rolling into the busy holiday season here at Crossroads including a New Ornament Expo which opened in November and we had great attendance for a new event! Make It and Take It Kids Craft Day at St Alphonsus Festival of Trees. We served over 174 kids and provided free attendance to Baker County Head Start and CASA kids and their siblings. Crossroads decorated the Raffle Tree for Festival of Trees and Bookkeeper Jana Simpson made beautiful swags which were donated on behalf of Crossroads. Crossroads takes seriously our role as a community partner and tries to help whenever we can.

## Update on Committees:

We are thrilled that our Board with the support of the Devos Institute for Art Management has really embraced the expansion of our Crossroads Committees and I wanted to do a snapshot for our members on what these committees are working on and who is on each committee.

### **SMALL FUNDRAISERS**

LuAnn Cook, Terry Drever – Gee and Lori Wood – are currently in the planning process for the Feed the Arts Soup Dinner on March 2nd here at Crossroads. All proceeds will go to the Hand to Heart Scholarship Fund. They are planning on a Mother's Day Tea under the leadership of Terri Bell, getting some training on how to have a Fun Run and are looking some summer events to help engage our audience in the our outdoor spaces.

### **MEMBERSHIP**

Megan McGuinness and Hilery Lay – have restructured the membership program including adding new multiple business memberships they are hoping to increase membership and increase the use of online payment options/auto renewals which will decrease Crossroads costs and the paper waste. All increases in membership have to be approved by the Board of Directors and if approved will be rolled out in the Spring of 2019. They are also working on a plan to rebrand Crossroads and will be joined by Community Art Director Kristin Hauter.

### **GRANT COMMITTEE**

Kathleen Chaves, Mary Tomlinson and Emily Denne – met and have proposed our first quarter set of grant strategy with members of the committee doing the grant writing on a portion of the grants. This committee will be developing a strategy based on the upcoming needs of the organization and will be less reactive and more proactive as we expand programs.

### **GALA COMMITTEE**

Katie Lamb, Janet Kahn – meet to debrief Gala and will begin the pre-planning process of the 2019 Gala "Vive'L Art- Art from Around the World" in February.

### **BUDGET**

Brian Watt and Terry Drever Gee – Presented a 2019 Balanced Budget to the board which was approved and will likely be amended as the end of year grants come in.

### **TECHNOLOGY AND ARTSPEAK COMMITTEES**

Both need to find volunteers to get them rolling. We need technological savvy people to help assess hardware needs for the next decade and to help identify best practices software. Access to a high quality website designer who can also help with the maintenance of our website is critical. Key need is to help staff develop RFQ's to successfully bid projects. Artspeak is pending the hiring of our new Education Coordinator. This committee will need to have representatives from our partnering social service agencies, school representatives, artists and community members as we develop a sustainable way to expand this critical program and to organize it to serve more at-risk children and adults.

### **SOS COMMITTEE**

This is not so much a committee as a work group. If you want to help or volunteer at Crossroads contact Ginger with your email address. We email SOS Requests out and try to include approximate time needed to complete the task. If you can do the project you reply if you can't no worries...hopefully someone else can! The more people on the list the quicker the projects get done!

### **TEMPORARY COMMITTEE**

We are needing the help of those most impacted by Missoula Children's Theatre to convene a work and focus group to get parental involvement in how we celebrate our 10th Season of MCT extra fabulous! We would like to invite all parents interested in brainstorming ideas to come to a quick meeting on January 7th at 6:00pm at Crossroads upstairs studio. All are welcome! Bring your great ideas!
